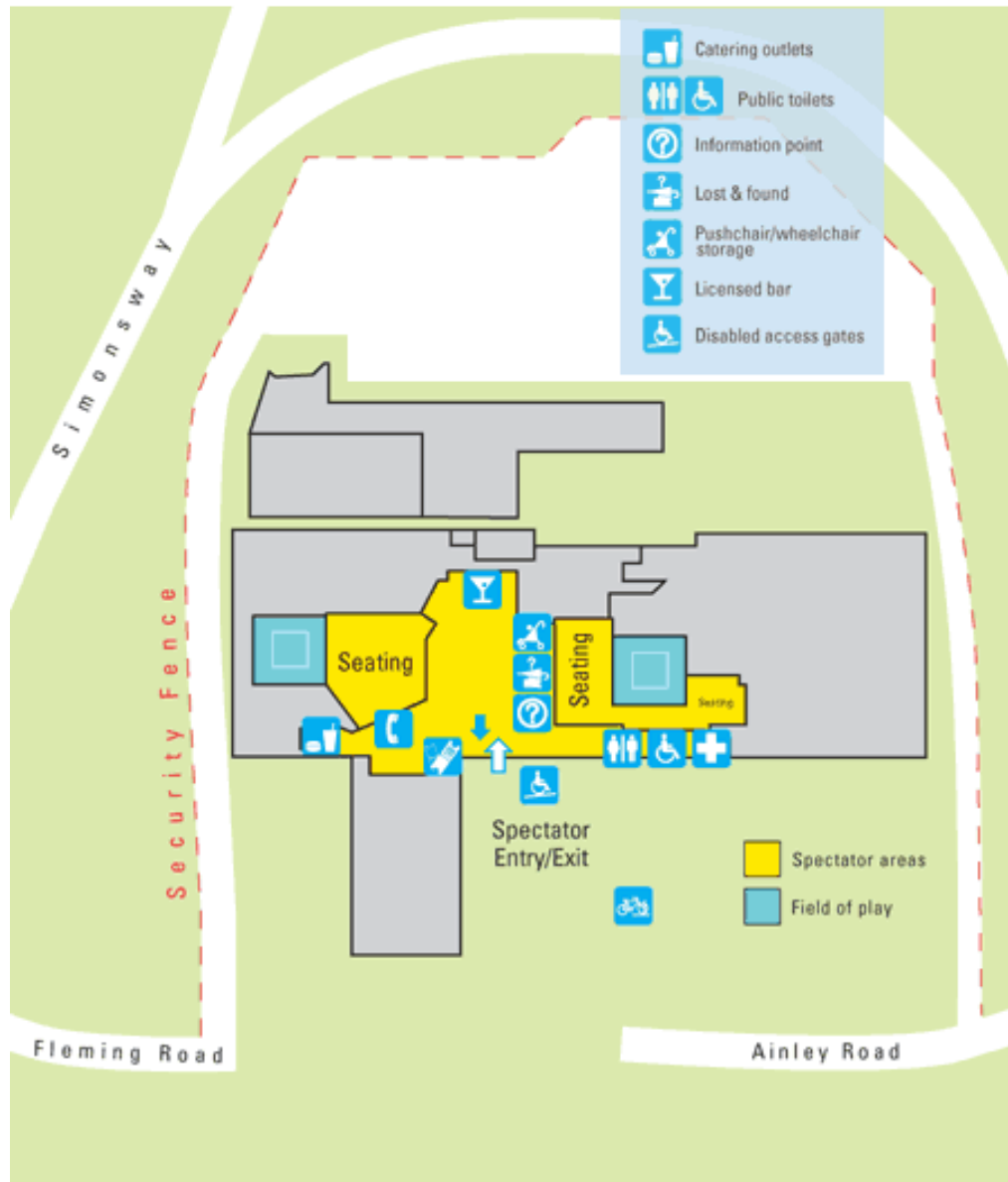
### Forum Centre, Wythenshawe map

### **Venue hours**

The venue will open 60 minutes before each session and close 30 minutes after each session

### **General venue rules**
